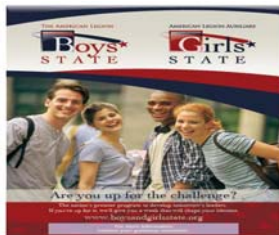


**Change You Can Believe In.**

## **Manslaughter trial Friday**

Sunday evening an incident occurred here at Georgia Boys State that involved hazing, underage drinking, and caused the death of one student. The victim, Jamie Johnson, was a freshman. Mayor Daniel McCoy of Gordon County, Defense Attorney for defense Pat Peterson, announced that Johnson died instantly from the impact of a blunt object to the head.

This case is unique, due to the fact that it made a direct violation of University policy. Peterson, who is being charged with involuntary manslaughter for this occurrence, feels very remorseful, according to informed sources.

Officer Taylor of the George Southern University police visited the Boys State general Session on Monday, to inform the citizens of the accident and request witnesses. Bob Beauchamp was required to read the hazing policy. Afterward, Dale Barnett informed the citizens of Boys State that a change of venue had been made to the superior courts of Washington, Adams, Jefferson, and Madison counties.

The mayor was very informative and stated “It is a tragedy; it is not pointing the finger...unfortunately there are college students that make wrong choices.” He also

stated that his primary defense was “inconsistency of witnesses, and the fact that all of the students’ acts were voluntary.”

This trial is set to take place in the Supreme Court on Friday morning.
